

The Kilgore Samaritan Counseling Center was founded in 1988 through the generosity of Betty Kilgore Moss Gibbs. She felt that there was a need for a ministry of pastoral counseling in the area. An interfaith Board of Directors was formed to govern the Center. Kilgore is a ministry of Second Presbyterian Church and St. Francis in the Fields Episcopal Church. The Center is one of two counseling programs in the metro Louisville area that have been accredited by the Samaritan Institute. At the core of the Samaritan center is a belief in the close relationship and balance between body, mind, spirit and community, while emphasizing that optimal health unifies all four. This approach integrates the psychological, medical and theological disciplines. To maintain Samaritan Institute accreditation, Kilgore must meet exceedingly high standards of professional as well as operational, administrative and procedural accountability.

Programs

Individual Counseling

Individual therapy is provided for adults, children and adolescents who are dealing with a crisis or long term issues. In individual therapy the client sees one therapist, usually for weekly 50 minute sessions.

Couples Therapy

In couples therapy, we work with both parties in joint as well as individual sessions to help find solutions to conflicts.

Family Therapy

When difficulties affect the entire family, all members may be seen together as well as individually to help build communication skills, reduce conflict and develop better relationships.

Group Therapy

Group therapy is offered to clients who wish to explore their feelings and thoughts and increase their ability to relate effectively to themselves and other persons.
