The Gardens

Primrose Terrace-this expansive garden has numerous outdoor rooms on multiple levels—great for entertaining or quiet contemplation.

“Trash to Treasure” Garden- this property has been transformed into a gardener’s paradise with its perennials, roses, iris and ferns, and unusual “yard art.”

Edgewood Garden-this garden includes a wonderful variety of early blooming perennials and a beautiful Pennsylvania Blue-stone terrace.

As I type this, I am looking out my office window and enjoying the warmth and the sunshine that comes with Spring. It is hard to imagine that just a short time ago – mid-February – I was looking out the same office window at the third major snow event in as many weeks and wondering whether we’d ever see Spring again. But the warmth is back! The snow is long gone, the sun has returned, and the flowers are in bloom – all signs that our annual Garden Tour is just around the corner (Saturday and Sunday, May 15th and 16th.) You may read more details about this year’s Tour elsewhere in this issue of our *Visions* newsletter.

This Spring, we will also be holding another important event – a “Welcome Home” Open House to celebrate our successful Capital Campaign and the move to our new facility, located at 918 Ormsby Lane. The Open House is scheduled for Sunday, June 6th from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. As many of you know, the Kilgore Center has recently purchased and refurbished its own facility, and we are so proud to open our new home to our many clients, donors,

vendors and others who have shown such generosity and dedication to our mission. Our “Welcome Home” Open House is our way of showing our donors what their generosity has made possible, and to introduce the community at large to our Staff, our Board, and our services. As a side note, if you are a client of the Center and wish to attend our Open House, please know that we have taken all precautions to assure your anonymity and confidentiality. All records are double locked as per HIPAA regulations and no attendee will have access to such records. In addition, because we expect general community attendance, no one should know whether you are a client, vendor, donor or interested party who wishes to learn more about us.

At both the Garden Tour and the Open House, we will have brochures and literature regarding our mission, our history, the nature of therapy and the specialties and qualifications of our staff. Measuring the effectiveness of “what exactly we do” in our work with clients and

families tends to be a bit elusive in that mental health process is not an exact science, as with, say biology or physics. There are of course “standards of practice” and “evidence-based” interventions, as well as test-retest methods that give us some idea about a given client’s degree of clinical improvement. That said, where the proverbial rubber meets the road, much of what we do is guided by the way a client-therapist relationship evolves and the trust built within that relationship. In this, a few statistics come to mind that might be worth noting here. First, my latest figures show that 69% of recent referrals have come to us either as returning clients from previous years, or by word of mouth and personal recommendation from a current or past client – 69%! A second statistic worth noting is that this year’s annual Client Satisfaction Survey, clients expressed a 97.9% overall level of satisfaction with the Center and a 97.8% level of assurance that they would return to the Center as needed. It would appear – “empirically,” as they say – that we’re having a significant and positive effect in our community.
